

EMERGENCY STAIRCASE REPAIR UPDATE

On Wednesday, contractors assigned by the Diocese inspected the emergency staircase. Their initial visual assessment revealed that the wood on the upper landing was rotten, requiring immediate replacement and reinforcement.

Upon closer examination, a more thorough inspection identified the need for extensive repairs in the spring to facilitate waterproofing of the outer walls. Once this work is completed, a new staircase will be constructed. A temporary fix for the stairs has been made until the largerscale repairs can begin.

To clarify, the affected staircase is not the one visible when entering the annex from the parking lot. It is located within the basement and designated exclusively for emergency use.

The basement door will remain locked. If you require access to store or retrieve any items, please let Fr. Arpee or the office know, and we will gladly coordinate that with you!

JUBILEE OF HOPE, 2025 The Diocese of Hamilton joins the celebration of the Global Church in this Ordinary Jubilee Year, 2025, as "Pilgrims of Hope!" We are all invited to journey through this year drawing closer to God through prayer, service and experiences of renewal. Six churches have been designated as pilgrimage sites across the Diocese, welcoming you as a visitor over the course of the Jubilee to come and pray. The year will be officially launched in each Parish in the Diocese on this dame day. The Jubilee Year of Hope will conclude n January 6, 2026.
